

BALLET ARTS STUDIO POLICIES

The Ballet Arts 2005/2006 School Year is divided into two (2) semesters: 1st Semester - August 22 through January; 2nd Semester - February through June 18.

Tuition and Fees:

Tuition: Tuition is payable in full at the beginning of each semester (or paid with monthly post-dated checks). Tuition is non-refundable and non-transferable unless withdrawal from the semester is due to illness or injury verified by a doctor's note. Students with past due accounts may not be admitted to class. Tuition amounts are listed on the Class Schedule. Tuition will be prorated for students who enroll after the semester has begun.

Registration Fee: Ballet Arts charges a yearly, non-refundable \$30 registration fee per student. It is good for the entire two-semester year, including Summer Ballet Camp. The registration form attached to this pamphlet must be completed and signed by the parent, before the student can begin classes.

Family Discounts: Families with two or more students registered will receive a 20% tuition discount for the second child, and 50% tuition discount for subsequent children! Registration fees will also be discounted to \$35 for the entire family.

1 Month Trial: If you would like your child to try a class before committing to it, you may sign up for a 1 month trial. You will be charged only for a month's worth of classes, and no registration fee will be collected. If after the fourth lesson you decide to continue with classes, you will be charged the registration fee as well as the remainder of the semester tuition. Payment is due in full at that time.

Dress Code:

Ballet: Plain, black leotard (no skirts please), pink tights, and pink ballet slippers (preferably split-soled). All ballet students must have their hair secured away from their faces with bobby pins, barrettes, head bands, etc. Long hair must be worn in a bun and neatly secured!

Jazz: T-shirt and leggings with jazz/tap shoes.

For your convenience, ballet dance wear and all dance shoes can be purchased at the studio.

Holidays/Studio Closures: The Ballet Arts studio will be closed on the following holidays:

Inclement Weather: Ballet Arts will follow the Kennewick School District for closures due to inclement weather. If school has been cancelled, you may assume that Ballet Arts will be cancelled for the day/evening as well.

Make-Up Classes: Make up classes are always available when students have missed their regular lesson due to a holiday, inclement weather closure, vacation or illness! Check with the receptionist to verify dates and times of available classes. Keep in mind that your child may attend a class one level up or down from his/her current class.
